

In-Task Schedules

To further reinforce this, an in task work schedule can be used. It is an A4 laminate of one half green and the other red. The work given to your pupil could be separated in to three activities and placed in three zip lock bags. On each of the bags have a triangle, square and circle (can be other symbols/numbers etc). On the work schedule duplicate this and place on the green side (work to be completed) When your Pupil completes an activity he can move this to the red tray and reinforce it is finished by moving the shape (Whichever was on the ziplock bag) on to the red section to reinforce it has finished and now only two activities to go. Each activity finished, the shape can be moved over to the finished section.

The left picture shows the work area to start with each activity in a zip lock bag with a different shape on. The picture on the right shows when activity has been completed they are moved to the red tray and the shapes are moved over to the right side.
