















Animals

<p>Animal</p>  <p>Palm down clawed hands make alternate forward circular clawing movements</p>	<p>Bee</p>  <p>"O" shaped thumb and index fingers twist at wrist and move inwards</p>	<p>Cat</p>  <p>Fingers flex as hands move out from sides of mouth to indicate whiskers</p>	<p>Cow</p>  <p>Thumbs and little fingers extended, thumbs on temples, twist from palm down to palm forward.</p>	<p>Dog</p>  <p>"N" hands pointing down make small movements down</p>	<p>Duck</p>  <p>Fingers open and close onto thumb in front of chin</p>	<p>Elephant</p>  <p>Full "C" hand moves forward then down in front of face in a curve to outline a trunk</p>
<p>Fish</p>  <p>Flat hand moves forwards with slight twisting movement from wrist</p>	<p>Horse</p>  <p>Fists, one on top of the other, move up and down (can be side by side)</p>	<p>Lion</p>  <p>Clawed hands make forward pouncing movement then draw a mane around head. Use a fierce expression!</p>	<p>Mouse</p>  <p>Tip of index finger contacts side of nose as hand makes repeated quick twisting movements</p>	<p>Pig</p>  <p>Fist makes small circles near nose</p>	<p>Rabbit</p>  <p>Palm forward "n" hands held at either side of head bend from palm knuckles several times</p>	<p>Sheep</p>  <p>Extended little fingers held at sides of head move forward/down in circular movement</p>
